The sounds 'f' 'l' 's' 'z' 'k' spelt ff, ll, ss, zz and ck.	The 'n' sound spelt n before k	-tch in words
Off, well, miss, buzz, back	Bank, think	Catch, fetch, kitchen, notch,
The 'v' sound at the end of words	Adding s and es to words	Adding the endings – ing, –ed and –er to verbs where no change is needed to the root word
Have, give, live	Cats, catches, dogs, thanks	Hunting, hunted, hunter
Adding –er and –est to adjectives where no change is needed to the root word	Compound words	Adding the prefix –un
Quicker, quickest	Football, playground, farmyard	Unhappy, undo, unload
Using k for the 'k' sound	ph and wh sound in words	Words ending in 'y' sounded 'l'
Kent, sketch, kit, skin	Dolphin, alphabet, where, which wheel	Very, happy, funny, party
