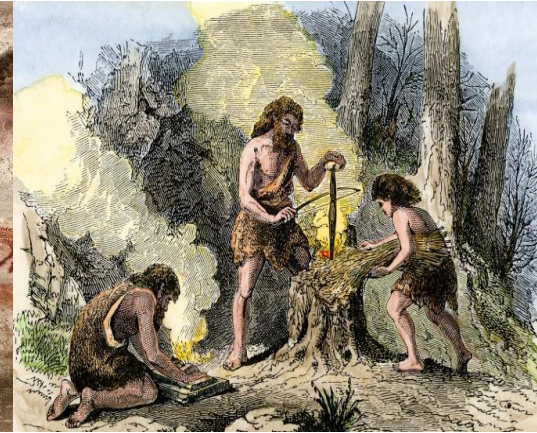
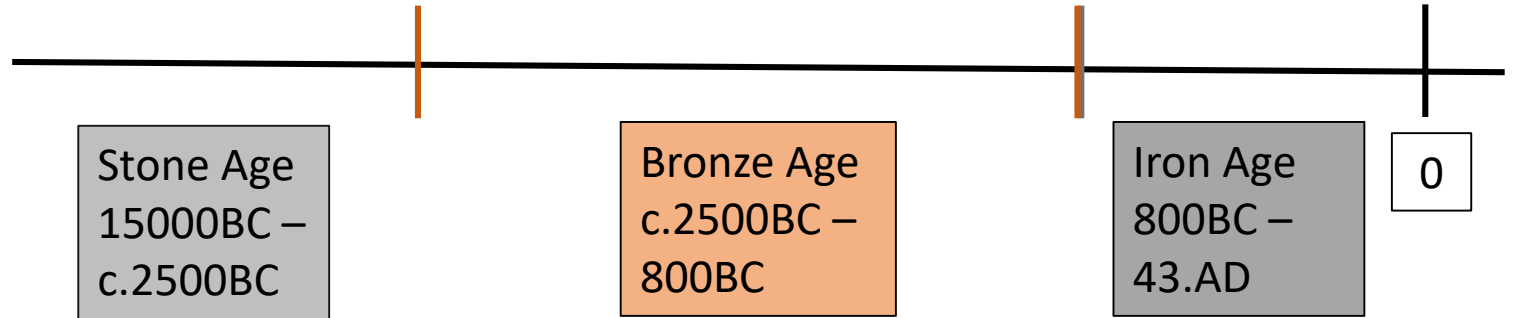


Year 3 Knowledge Mat: Stone, Bronze and Iron Age

| Subject Specific Vocabulary | |

| Neolithic | The final division of the Stone Age. First introduction of farming instead of hunting and gathering. |
| Cave Painting | Paintings from the stone age found in caves. |
| Spear, Borer, Throwing Stones, Hand Axe, Hammerstone | Stone Age weapons and tools. |
| Stonehenge | A monument built by Bronze Age man 2,500BC. |
| Roundhouse | A style of house made of wood. Animals lived in the house with humans. |
| Agriculture | When people grow crops to eat and look after animals for eating. |
| Skara Brae | Best preserved stone age village located in the Orkney Isles. |
