



Year 3 Knowledge Mat: Stone, Bronze and Iron Age

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Neolithic	The final division of the Stone Age. First introduction of farming instead of hunting and gathering.
Cave Painting	Paintings from the stone age found in caves.
Spear, Borer, Throwing Stones, Hand Axe, Hammerstone	Stone Age weapons and tools.
Stonehenge	A monument built by Bronze Age man 2,500BC.
Roundhouse	A style of house made of wood. Animals lived in the house with humans.
Agriculture	When people grow crops to eat and look after animals for eating.
Skara Brae	Best preserved stone age village located in the Orkney Isles.


