## Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter

December 2025

As usual this has been a busy half term combining lots of fantastic learning with the fun and celebrations that lead us into Christmas.

We have learnt about the Ancient Greeks and how our lives today are still influenced by them. We found out about the lives of people living in Ancient Greece as well as the Gods and Goddesses they believed in. We then used our knowledge to make and design our own miniature Greek pots.

In English we wrote our own narratives based on the story of ‘Small in the City’ writing the story from the point of view of the cat in the story. We then went on to write fantasy stories based on the story of ‘Leon and the between.

In Maths, the children have been working on developing their multiplication and division skills. We have been learning how to use arrays and our times tables knowledge to solve multiplication problems and sharing and grouping to solve division problems. We are also continuing to investigate and solve reasoning questions.

Our PSHE has been focusing on Celebrating Differences with a focus on understanding how to avoid conflict with others and how to solve conflicts when they arise. The children are continuing to enjoy a variety of books in our Guided Reading sessions. In Science, we learnt about animals and living things, including humans. We learnt about the bones that make up the human skeleton and the muscles that support it. We also learnt about how to help our bodies stay healthy. The children have been learning about the names of animals in our Spanish lessons.

In our Gymnastics lessons the children have had lots of fun turning their own sequence of movements into a routine that they performed to the rest of the class.
