Geography

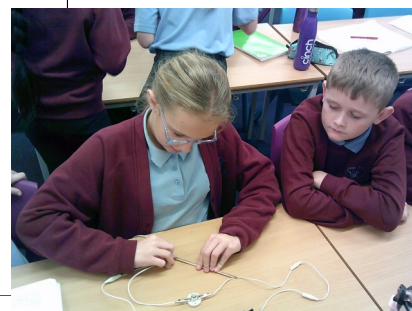

This term we will be learning.....
