This half term our topic has been Snow and Ice, and the children have shown enthusiasm and curiosity throughout. We have explored some key facts about arctic animals, including polar bears, penguins, snowy owls, arctic foxes and seals. The children enjoyed learning about where these animals live and how they are suited to cold environments.

We have also been on welly walks, where we talked about the weather and what we could see and feel around us. These walks encouraged lots of discussion and helped developed the children’s understanding of the world around them.

## This term we will be learning.....

This half term our topic is Animals. As part of our learning, we will be setting up a Vet's role play area. The children will explore how to look after pets by caring for toy animals, talking about what animals need to stay healthy, and learning about kindness and responsibility.

We will also be going on a minibeast adventure, learning about habitats, creating Spring collages, exploring animal prints and making sensory boxes. These activities support the children's learning through play and link to communication and language, physical development, understanding the world and expressive arts and design.
