Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter

In English the children took inspiration from ‘Last Stop on Market Street’ by Matt de la Pena and Christian Robinson. They used their senses to describe the setting and characters and created their own characters to include in a retelling of the story. From the book ‘Lizzy and the Cloud’ by the Fan Brothers the children applied all of their English learning from the year to write a guidebook for caring for their own cloud! As a result the children are now able to use words such as ‘confine’, ‘unpredictable’ and ‘precaution’.

In Maths they completed their topic on Statistics where children learnt how to complete and interpret tally charts, block diagrams and pictograms. The children also used the language of clockwise, anti-clockwise, left and right to describe turns and movements of objects.

Science was very topical as the children learned the importance of the words Reduce, Reuse and Recycle and showed a good understanding of these concepts. They made connections between the materials that are used to make objects and whether or not the object could be used again.

In RE the children learned about Humanists and how they live their lives by being kind and considerate to others, following the Golden Rule—treat others as you would like them to treat you.
