It is hard to believe that we've reached the end of the academic year – how quickly the time has flown! It has been an absolute pleasure to teach your children, and we're so proud of everything they've achieved.

This term has been packed with learning and exciting activities. We spent an afternoon doing a local area walk, and only got a little bit wet! We also have made use of the forest and pond areas to help us listen to the sounds of the world around us and support our English learning, and had an afternoon with our new classes to help the children prepare for Year 4. Hopefully the weather will allow us to fit a re-arranged Sports Day in too.

In English, we wrote amazing fantasy stories based on an underwater part of London and used our imaginations to plan our own adventures. The children also wrote fantastic narratives about an adventure that takes place because of a fall into another world.

In Maths, we focused on learning to tell the time. We'd encourage you to keep practising this important skill over the summer to help build confidence. We have also worked on gathering information and then recording that information accurately using bar charts and pictograms.

In Science, we did an experiment to explore whether there is a relationship between a person's hand span and the strength of their grip. We used a variety of different sized fruit to conduct this experiment and it was a lot of fun! In History we also looked at what life was like in Roman Britain.

Over the past few weeks, we've spent time preparing for the transition into Year 4. The children have had opportunities to share their thoughts and feelings, ask questions, and express any worries in a supportive environment.

We want to thank all the children for their hard work, enthusiasm, and resilience this year. It's been a fantastic journey and we are proud of how much they have achieved.
